

SALMON CREEK PARK PURCHASES PROPOSED

The resolution which is expected to be put before the Board of Supervisors on July 1 will ask for \$285,000 in federal aid toward purchase of land for the new 1,000-acre Salmon Creek Park in Sweden and Ogden. The proposal comes from the Supervisors' Parks and Recreation Committee.

Total cost of the land was estimated at \$950,000, with the county sharing \$85,000 of the cost, and the federal and state government the rest. The state approved \$650,000 for an 800-acre Salmon Creek Park, an addition to Churchville Park and a new Oatka Creek Park. An amendment will be made to the county's Salmon Creek application to include the additional 200 acres.

Another proposal would authorize obtaining options for a proposed 41-acres addition to Churchville Park. The land, located south of Black Creek, would give control of both banks of the creek to the county.

Parks Director Wilbur E. Wright said that the new park in Chili is still under consideration by the county, and will remain on a priority list.
